Why is there a fee for activities?

We are required to charge a minimal contribution fee to families. These out-of-pocket costs help with expenses, including entry fees, activity supplies and all the extra sparkle in programs that are not covered by the NDIS.

- Suitable outdoor clothing for park play
- Appropriate shoes for walking and sports play
- Any assistive technology equipment (mobility, communication, technology, etc.) that your child requires.

Medication requirements:

- A Medication Authority form is required if your child takes medication and will need VMCH to administer it during the program or camp
- Webster pack or original packaging must include a pharmacy label with the patient's name and dosage

While VMCH takes all reasonable steps to ensure the safety and wellbeing of participants, involvement in program activities may involve some inherent risk. These may include minor injuries, accidents, transport-related risks, environmental exposure, or changes in routine that may impact emotional or physical wellbeing. All activities are planned with appropriate supervision, risk assessments, and safety supports; however, risk cannot be eliminated in group and community-based programs.

By signing this form, you acknowledge that you have been informed about the program and understand the potential risks involved. You consent to your child/participant participating in all program activities, including overnight camps (where applicable), community outings, and transport arrangements.

You agree to provide VMCH with all relevant documentation before the commencement of the program, including Behaviour Support Plans, medication authority forms, and health management plans (e.g., Asthma Management Plan), and to notify VMCH of any updates or changes that may impact safe participation.

You also consent to VMCH staff seeking medical assistance for your child/participant in the event of an emergency.

We encourage families to raise any questions or concerns with the program coordinator prior to commencement. We look forward to a safe, inclusive, and enjoyable School Holiday Program.
